Dear Friends,

There is a Old Hymn called "Break Thou the Bread of Life". The fourth verse reads: O send Thy spirit Lord. Now unto me, That He may touch my eyes, And make me see; Show me the truth concealed within Thy Word, And in Thy book revealed I see the Lord. The Lord has been faithful to me thru His Word. During the months of March and April I worked as an intern in the Prayer Ministry Department at the Wycliffe USA headquarters in Orlando, Florida.

This was a journey of humility and trusting Him to take care of meeting my many needs for this internship transportation, room and board and miscellaneous. I specifically sought the Lord to provide for me. I filed my income taxes for 2008 and my refund was what I needed. BUT, God. He supplied every need and some of my wants. I am grateful for all I learned from those in the Prayer Ministry department and others in Orlando. I feel much more prepared to take on the prayer facilitator role in the Eastern Congo Group (ECG). Prayer is the Key that unlocks doors.

One week after arrival in Orlando, I was asked to give my testimony to over 300 staff members at their Annual Retreat. I testified about the call to say "Yes" in the Present. What a privilege.

One of the greatest highlights of the internship was participating in the Spring Scripture Celebration, rejoicing in ten Bibles recently completed in the heart languages of people around the world. I was allowed to carry in the Bible for the Markweta community in Kenya. This project was started in 1987 and completed in 2008. Markweta is one of 12 languages for the Kalenjin clan with a population of 80,000. Daniel Moi, a member of the Kalenjin clan, was president of Kenya between 1978 and 2002. In 1998 I was privileged to be in Kenya with missionaries from Christian Stronghold (my church) and we were invited to the State House to meet then President Daniel Moi. So it was very special to carry in the Markweta Bible. BUT God.

It has been almost 11 years since I first stepped onto African soil. Genesis 26 talks about Isaac's obedience to the Lord during a famine. God kept His promise to bless Isaac. He faced many obstacles while in "Gerar". It was located on the edge of a desert where water was precious. I can relate to this in today's economic times. But God desires us to trust and obey Him. Scripture tells us to keep asking, and we will receive what we ask for. Keep on seeking, and we will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened. I have completed my prayer internship training, but I still need more monthly financial support to be able to work and live in Kenya for several years.

To date the Lord has provided partners to meet 10% of the monthly needs; 100% is needed.

I also need prayer partners to uphold me as I prepare for this assignment and then go and begin work in ECG. I need financial partners to trust God. Bible translation is a partnership with churches and individuals.
